# AGATE Mini-Grants!

Grants will be awarded to fund individual projects up to **\$500** each.  
All grant applications must be submitted via email by **November 15**  
All applications will be in the following 3 section format:

1. **Demographic Information:** Include name, school, position, address, phone number, email address, and estimated number of students to benefit from your project.
2. **Idea for Serving Gifted Students:** Write a paragraph explaining your idea for serving your gifted students. Include evidence of need, the source of your idea, and how you would implement this idea in your classroom or area.
3. **Evidence of Cost:** Provide evidence of the cost for your idea. This could be a scanned copy of a receipt or catalog page, a link to a website catalog page, or any other form of cost proof. Please do not send multi-page websites – just the part applicable to you.

Grants will not be awarded for stipends, professional development, or other such expenses.
